We have hit the ground running and have many things happening this week.

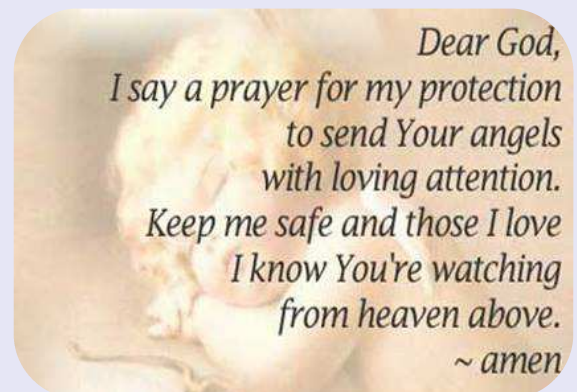
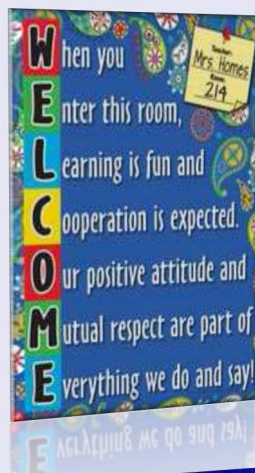

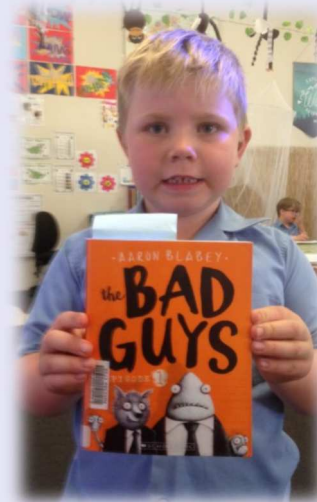
### Dallas: Rangers Apprentice—The Early Years
